PASSES

Transfer Policy

Transfer Prices: Transfers between Pace buses are 25 cents, 15 cents reduced. The total cost with a transfer is \$2.00, \$1.00 reduced on regular and local feeder routes.

Transfers can be used for two trips following the initial ride. These trips must be taken within two (2) hours of the beginning of the initial ride. Reverse riding on the route of purchase using a Pace transfer is allowed within the two-hour time limit. Reverse riding is **NOT** allowed using free local transfers. Local transfers are available in Aurora, Joliet, Elgin and Waukegan, and are valid for one hour. Surcharges apply on Premium Fare routes.

EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2006 CTA WILL NO LONGER ACCEPT A PACE TRANSFER FOR FARE PAYMENT.

CTA Transit Card/Chicago Card/RTA Reduced Fare Permits

These cards have value stored on the card, and value is subtracted for each use. The value subtracted is based on Pace Regular Fares and transfer prices. Passengers using the cards and transferring pay \$1.75 for their trip (transfer prices are subtracted from the card value when used). If the card has insufficient value, the farebox will indicate the amount to be added. Surcharges may apply on Premium Fare routes.

Only two transfers are allowed following the initial use. Transfer trips must be taken within two (2) hours of the initial ride. Transfers are stored on the card itself. Stored value cards are not accepted on Pace or buses without bus ticket processing units (BTPU's).

TYPES OF RIDERS

FULL FARE RIDER

- 12 years of age and older except as below.

***REDUCED FARE RIDER**

- 65 years of age and older presenting valid RTA Reduced Fare Card. A medicare card along with another source of identification with a photograph and a date of birth is acceptable to obtain the RTA reduced fare card. For further information, please contact the RTA at 836-7000 from all Chicagoland area codes.
- Riders with disabilities, regardless of age, presenting either a current RTA Temporary Reduced Fare Card or an RTA Permanent Reduced Fare Card.
- High school, junior high and grammar school students 12 through 20 years of age presenting a valid CTA Student Riding Permit, Pace Permit or valid school I.D. between 6:00 A.M. and 8:00 P.M. only on school days (Mon. - Fri.) for purposes of travel to and from classes, work/study programs, and on-campus extracurricular activities during these times. **Reduced fare 30-Day Passes or reduced fare Commuter Club Cards are NOT valid for students. The Pace Haul Pass is available for student use.**
- 7 through 11 years of age.

FREE RIDER - Does not apply to Paratransit or ADA Service.

- Children under age 7, when accompanied by a rider presenting a pass or by a full or reduced fare-paying adult rider (Maximum of two children for each fare-paying adult rider. Additional children require a payment of a reduced fare).
- CTA employees presenting a current CTA Employee's Identification Card/Riding Pass.
- Pace employees presenting a current Pace Employee ID Riding Pass and Pace subsidized carrier employees presenting a current Pace Riding Pass.
- Pace and CTA pensioners presenting a current Pensioner's Identification card.
- Police officers in full uniform; if not in full uniform, they must present their star or badge with their current police identification card.
- Passenger with authorized promotional ticket (Free Ride Coupon).
- 65 years of age and older and a resident of the six county RTA region (Cook, Lake, Kane, Will, McHenry and DuPage Counties) presenting a valid RTA Senior Ride Free Permit may ride Pace Fixed Route Service free of charge.
- Passengers with Disabilities presenting a RTA Ride Free Circuit Permit.
- Active Military Personnel in uniform
