MCRIDE IS A GREAT WAY TO GET AROUND MCHENRY COUNTY!

GETTING A RIDE

As a dial-a-ride program, MCRide service is a "coordinated countywide paratransit service: and buses do not travel in a fixed route each day. Riders schedule their trips in advance and the vehicle provides curb-to-curb service from the rider's desired pick-up and drop-off destinations.

To schedule a ride, call the Pace Call Center at 1-800-451-4599 or 711 for the Illinois Relay Service. Call takers will register you during your first call. Seniors (60+) and Individuals with Disabilities can schedule a ride up to seven days in advance of their trip. The general public can schedule a ride up to two days in advance of their trip.

Remember to schedule your initial pick up and the return trip. Riders unable to keep a reservation must cancel their trip at least two hours before the scheduled pick-up time.

WHERE & WHEN CAN I RIDE?

All individuals are eligible for travel within McHenry County and some parts of Kane and Lake counties. Whether you need transportation for work, school, shopping, or medical appointments, MCRide provides a flexible way to travel. MCRide service operates every day, except for holidays, from **5:00 am to 11:00 pm.**

Call 1-800-451-4599 to schedule a ride.

HOW MUCH IS A TRIP?

The fares for the general public are \$4.00 for the first five miles. Fares for seniors (60+) and individuals with a disability are \$2.00 for the first five miles. All riders are charged \$0.25 per mile after the first five miles. When you call to make a trip reservation, the Call Center will tell you how much your fare will be. MCRide currently only accepts cash fares.
