### **How it Works**

A Pace Vanpool can be formed with four or more commuters who have similar work schedules and commutes to work. Someone in the group volunteers to drive. Pace manages the program. Riders share the costs.

#### **Pace Vanpooling includes:**

- Smoke-free Pace van
  A minivan for up to 7 participants and a conversion van for larger groups.
- Insurance
   Pace provides automobile liability coverage for authorized drivers.
- Fuel & van washes
- Maintenance
- Roadside assistance
- All Illinois Tollway tolls
- A Guaranteed Ride Home
   For personal emergencies, the backup driver fills in and you get up to \$125 per year for transportation. This does not apply to overtime.
- Guidance
   Pace provides driver training and assigns a representative to assist.
- Forming a group
   To form a group or grow the group size, invite others, or create an account at: PaceCommuterRideShare.com.

## **Drive and Save**

All primary drivers participate for FREE.

Riders who become backup drivers can earn a monthly fare discount:

\$25 off - Full-time participant

\$15 off - Part-time participant (3 days or less per week)

Take control of your commute. Invite three of your coworkers to join you in forming a vanpool. Enjoy the advantages of Pace perks, where primary drivers receive personal miles in exchange for volunteering to drive. By participating, you can lessen the burden of car ownership, minimize wear and tear on your own vehicle and potentially lower your personal auto insurance costs. Remember, drivers are not Pace employees or contract workers.

## The Pace Vanpool Program offers an economical, convenient alternative to driving alone and carpooling.

Vanpoolers live or work in Cook, DuPage, Kane, Lake, McHenry or Will counties. Groups range in size from 3-14 passengers.

#### **TRADITIONAL**

For traveling between home and work.

#### **PERSONAL MILES**

Primary drivers receive 300 personal miles per month which can be banked up to 500 miles for future use.

#### **PARKING**

Vans must be parked off the street.

#### **FEEDER**

For a first or last mile connection to and from bus, train, and park-and-ride locations.

#### **PERSONAL MILES**

Vans are allowed 600 miles per month for the work commute, maintenance, lunch, errands, etc.

#### **PARKING**

Vans are parked at bus, train and park-n-ride locations. Overnight and weekend parking could depend on availability and lot rules.

## **Driver Requirements**

#### All drivers must...

- be at least 21 years of age and hold a valid, unrestricted IL, IN or WI driver's license for at least 3 years
- have stable employment and a good driving record
- possess minimum insurance coverage on the driver's personal vehicle(s) required by IL, IN or WI.
- pass a DOT physical and drug test and complete the Pace Vanpool Defensive Driving Training course

All drivers are volunteers and not Pace employees or contract workers. The primary driver's credit card is kept on file to address any excess personal mileage, unauthorized fuel card purchases or I-pass usage.

Visit PaceVanpool.com to view all the requirments and applications. All participants must sign a driver agreement. Backup drivers sign both the driver and rider agreements.
