

How it works.

VanGo is a reservation-based round-trip service that is designed so you can drive within a defined zone for getting to and from your job any day of the week, 24 hours a day. Once you are registered and have met the proper safety requirements, you can reserve a van. The VanGo van can also be used during the lunch hour. Your fares will be billed monthly. Pace will handle maintenance and refueling at no extra cost to you.

Get Started.

1. Register.

Drivers must meet the following requirements:

- Be at least 21 years of age.
- Have a good driving record.
- Pass a physical and drug test.
- Complete an online driver training class.
- Provide copies of your valid driver's license and insurance.

All drivers and riders must visit PaceBus.com/VanGo to complete:

- An application and agreement.
- A credit card authorization form.

2. Make Reservations.

Registered commuters can call or email to book a Pace van. A text or email confirmation will include an assigned vehicle number and door and key entry code.



Rider reservations are accepted only on the days when pre-registered drivers are scheduled.


No monthly commitment! Just reserve a ride on the days you need it.

3. Participate for free as a driver when you invite riders to join your group.

Fares are **\$5.00 per day** for round-trip service. Drivers who travel with a pre-registered rider participate at no cost. Monthly invoices are provided. Based on usage, service is automatically charged to an authorized credit card and/or transit benefit card.



What type of van is used?

VanGo vans are either a 7-passenger Dodge Grand Caravan or 2020 Ford Transit conversion van with the VanGo logo. Pace staff will fuel, wash and maintain the vehicles to the highest standards.

Each vehicle includes:

- Video event recorders with GPS and geo-fencing.
- A door access keypad on the window.
- A key storage locker.
- Roadside assistance.
- Automobile liability coverage for authorized drivers.



How do I access the van?

Commuters can find a VanGo van in the designated parking area at the University Park Metra Station. Enter the access code into the keypad on the window to open the door and unlock the key locker. To start the van, insert the key into the ignition. Vans must be locked when not in use. Upon return, park the van in the assigned spot, return the key to the key locker and lock the van by pressing the lock button on the window keypad.

Regular VanGo user? Consider a Pace Feeder Vanpool.

If you plan to use this service regularly for 2-3 days per week, our Feeder Vanpool might be a better fit and offer more savings. Feeder Vanpools require a group of 4 or more commuters. All Vanpool drivers participate at no cost and get personal use of the van. Riders pay a low monthly fare based on distance, group size and frequency of participation. In some cases, the fare could be less than \$5 per day. Visit PaceBus.com/feeder-vanpool.
